PRO-VE 2023 Special Session

Agile production networks in the digitalisation era

Scope

Agility is among the top priorities of companies to keep up with the rapidly changing business context. It is no surprise that the definition and implementation of an agility strategy should consider context peculiarities and available resources. The literature contributed to conceptualising agility in project context and to some extent in production with a focus on strategic capabilities. This special session aims to explore enablers of agility at tactical and operational levels in production networks, with a focus on digitalisation methods and technologies. Production networks are hereby not only restricted to manufacturing factories but may also include mobile construction sites. Theoretical developments and empirical research are both welcome.
